### **SUMMARY**

It is not often that the opportunity to buy a new boat at such a competitive price comes along. Fitted out to a high standard on a quality Alexander shell, this boat is comprehensively equipped and the inventory even includes crockery!

The shell is typically elegant and with long, clean fore and aft swims should be a be joy to handle. Ample power is provided by the 43hp Beta engine. Oak panelling and oodles of contrasting mahogany trim contrive to give the cabin a reassuringly solid and cosy feeling whilst the fully tiled bathroom is bright and airy. The spacious accommodation offers a good degree of flexibility and includes an L-shaped dinette, which converts into a double bed, and a large saloon area with two easy chairs. There is also a double cross-berth which makes the most of the available space in the bedroom. Heating is by a convenient Eberspacher compact diesel boiler central heating system and a cosy multi-fuel stove in the saloon. Electrical power for the cabin and inverter comes from a bank of no less than five batteries. A brand new boat

without all the hassle of having one built to order, all you need to do is think of the name - what's not to like?

#### **ELECTRIC SUPPLY**

**Twin alternators: 12V 45A** alternator charges 1 x 110Ah engine battery • **12V 175A** alternator charges 5 x 110Ah cabin batteries • Charging also from a Sterling **80A marine charger**/inverter when landline is connected

The cabin 12V system is protected by circuit breakers in a labelled, switched panel

230V circuit installed with one landline connection

Independent onboard 230V power from batteries via Sterling 2.5kW pure sine wave inverter/charger which automatically switches to charger mode with 230V supply connected

A **galvanic isolator** is fitted to inhibit possible hull corrosion from the 230V earth bonding

Protected by consumer unit with residual current device (RCD) and MCB overcurrent protection

#### **ELECTRIC FITTINGS**

**Lights 12V:** 11 brass deckhead tungsten lights (remotely switched), 7 brass recessed halogen downlighters, weatherproof light in cratch

Power sockets:

**12V:** 0 **230V:** 9

Maxview TV aerial to internal Maxview signal booster with two aerial sockets

#### WINDOWS & DOORS

7 aluminium framed **windows**, 36in wide x 21in deep, all with top dropback hopper panels • 2 x 16in diameter opening **portholes** • Frames and portholes are gold-anodised

The forward bulkhead carries steel-skinned doors with interior timber linings

Aft & side doors are of steel with timber linings

#### **ENGINE**

Beta Marine B43 diesel • 4 cylinders, 43hp at 2,800rpm • Engine built by Kubota • Marinised by Beta Marine


Cooling is through a sealed skin tank

Engine control by a single lever

Instruments: Voltmeter, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge, tachometer, hour meter

Warning lights: Two charge, oil pressure, water temperature, panel on

Fuel: Approx 40 gallons (estimated) in integral tank



# STERN GEAR & TRANSMISSION

**Engine flexibly mounted** with Python sophisticated flexible coupling/thrust bearing/vibration damper

**PRM 150 hydraulic gearbox** with 2:1 reduction to 18in x 12in propeller • Weedhatch held down by quick-release bar **easily accessible** through a hinged steel lid in the aft deck • Stern tube lubrication by remote screw greaser • An electric bilge pump drains the stern tube sump

### STEELWORK & STYLE

10/6/5/4 plating with flat bottom bottom

**Shell in traditional style** • Enhanced by scrolled fore & aft cants & handrails, stop beam • 1 set of side doors

Traditional cabin edge handrails • Raised guards round the bow • Well deck seat-lockers • Midship rope ring on cabin roof • Recessed eyes for side fenders in gunwales

(Note plating thickness cannot be measured during ABNB visits and is based on reported information)

#### **DECKS**

Well deck and aft deck are of steel and are selfdraining

Well & aft decks have matting

Gunwales & cabin roof are finished with slipresistant surfaces

# TRAD FITTINGS

Traditional fittings include: A glazed, decorated cratch board and fitted cover with zins

Brasswork: Chimney bands, portholes, tiller & pin, mushroom vents, navigation lights

#### **BATHROOM**

Fully tiled

**Hip bath** 46in x 28in with curtain, shower over & tiled surround

Thetford C200CS cassette wc with swivel seat and pressbutton flush

### CABIN HEATING

Morsø Squirrel 4.5kW **solid fuel stove**, set in tiled fireplace

Eberspächer 4kW compact diesel boiler, controlled by digital timer, runs 3 radiators, 2 with thermostatic valves

Boiler supplied from 15 gallons (approx) integral diesel wing tanks under aft deck

### WATER HEATING

12 gallons (approx) lagged **calorifier** heated by engine and central heating boiler and 230V immersion heater

### **FURNISHINGS**

**Dinette upholstery** is green dralon-type piped fabric

**Curtains** are light green, lined & hung on brass rods with brass retainers

Floor is fitted with beige speckled carpet in the saloon, dinette and bedroom • Light marble effect vinyl iin the galley and bathroom

#### **BEHIND THE LININGS**

**Ballast:** The underfloor space contains engineering brick ballast laid on the waxoyled bottom plate and a membrane

**Insulation:** The cabin is insulated by **rockwool** behind all external linings (except underfloor)

#### **SLEEPING**

4 berths in 2 cabins, consisting of:

6ft 0in x 4ft 4in permanent double crossbed (or can be altered by builder to be a lengthways bed)

6ft 4in x 4ft 0in double on L-shaped dinette

#### **WATER SYSTEM**

H&C supply resin sink & drainer unit in galley & to bathroom



**ALARMS** 

Linings: Hull sides are lined with carpet • Cabin sides & headlining (ceiling) lined in oak-veneered mdf • Bulkheads (partitions) in oak-veneered mdf

**Furniture:** All furniture is custom-built oak-veneered mdf with routered mahogany framing & edging • Galley worktops are laminate with tiled splashback • Vanity unit worktop & splashback are tiled

#### **FINISHES**

**Hull:** Lower hull sides coated with Comastic • Hull sides above top rubbing strake finished in black enamel

**Superstructure:** Painted green with red framing, coachline is orange

**Traditional decoration:** Aft doors are traditionally painted externally • Bow carries sun & moon panels either side of stem post, counter carries white over red panels
