SUMMARY

Starting life as an empty shell in the owners' workshop he commissioned Anthony M to undertake the fitting out giving himself time to concentrate on other aspects of the build. This includes hours lovingly spent grinding, linishing and polishing the welds smooth, resulting in a very tactile & sharp-edge free shell. Plus, sourcing chrome fittings and using stainless steel fixings throughout; neat and labelled installations of all services and equipment; and finally the application of many coats of epoxy based paint to the superstructure. Andy Russell was commissioned for the splendid signwriting & decoration and during its time under cover the hull has been treated with coat upon coat of Comastic vinyl tar. It's been a somewhat leisurely build taking around five years to complete *Escapade* but now is the time for her to experience life afloat. Limited lift and transportation costs are included in the price.

ELECTRIC SUPPLY

Twin alternators: 12V 45A alternator charges 1 x 77Ah maintenance free engine battery & 1 x 110Ah bow thruster battery • 12V 175A alternator charges 5 x 110Ah maintenance free cabin batteries • Sterling digital monitor displays several parameters of charge rate & battery state • Engine & bow thruster batteries are separated by a blocking diode, to avoid flattening the engine battery • Charging to cabin batteries also by 60A inverter/charger • Trickle charging to cabin batteries also from CTek 3.6A charger

The 12V cabin system is protected by circuit breakers in a labelled, switched panel

230V circuit installed with two landline connections, forward & aft via a selection switch • Independent onboard 230V power from batteries via Sterling ProCombi S 2.1kW pure sine wave inverter/charger • Independent onboard 230V power also from Dometic Travelpower 3.5kW 230V engine driven generator

• Sterling ProSwitch 32 automatically chooses between landline, inverter and generator to ensure that only one 230V power source is used at any one time • A galvanic isolator is fitted to inhibit possible hull corrosion from 230V earth bond • Protected by earth leakage & overcurrent RCBO with overload circuit breakers

THRUSTER

BOW

12V 4hp QL-BP600 (distributed by Volvo) bow thruster • Watertight bulkhead • Powered by 110Ah battery adjacent to reduce voltage drop • Charged by engine start alternator • Control is by rocker switch

WINDOWS & DOORS

8 x 11in diameter opening **chrome portholes**

The forward bulkhead carries steel skinned glazed doors with interior timber linings • Two sets of side doors with inner hinged glazed doors • Side, aft & far aft doors are steel skinned with panelled oak interior linings

GENERATOR

Dometic Travelpower 3.5kW engine driven generator provides 230V power at variable engine speed

ENGINE

Beta Marine B43 diesel, 4 cylinders, 43hp at 2,800rpm • Engine built by Kubota, marinised by Beta Marine


Cooling is through a sealed skin tank • Compartment insulated with acoustic foam • Engine noise is further reduced by 'hospital-type' silencer

Engine control by single lever

Instruments: Voltmeter, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge, tachometer, hour meter

Warning lights: 2 charge, oil pressure, temperature, panel on

Fuel in approx 47 gallons integral tank with contents gauge

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STERN GEAR & TRANSMISSION

Engine flexibly mounted with Centaflex flexible coupling

Transmission by PRM 150 hydraulic gearbox with 2:1 reduction to 18in x 12in propeller

The **weedhatch** is of the self-contained, non-sinking design and includes a quick-release lid • Stern tube lubricated by remote screw greaser

An automatic electric bilge pump drains the stern tube sump

STEELWORK & STYLE

10/6/5/4 Plating with flat bottom

Shell in semi-traditional style • Enhanced by smoothed welds, recessed aft cabinside panels, scooped handrails, scribed aft deck, replica rivets, cabin top stop beam

Fittings that are part of the shell steelwork include: Traditional cabin-edge handrails and deck edge cants

 Raised guards around the bow · Chrome pole & plank rack on cabin roof · Lockable seat lockers fore and aft
 Midship rope eye on cabin roof · Recessed eyes for side fenders in topstrake

(Note plating thickness cannot be measured during ABNB visits and is based on reported information)

DECKS

Forward well deck & aft deck are of steel and are self-draining

Access to the engine is through a lockable aluminium panel, which sits on self-draining bearers in the semi-trad deck

Gunwales, decks and roof, are finished with slip resistant surfaces

TRAD FITTINGS

Chromework:

Portholes, tiller & pin, mushroom vents, fairleads, 4 folding stirrup steps (which make climbing onto the cabin roof easier), 2 houdini skylights, tunnel light, horn, navigation lights • All with stainless steel fixings

SHOWER ROOM

Shower 31in x 30in in laminated cubicle with glass and aluminium door

Feature oval washbasin on vanity unit

Jabsco macerator flush pump-out wc to remote 94 gallon (approx) polypropylene tank with Vetus contents gauge



The Hobbit 4kW **solid fuel stove**, set in decoratively tiled fireplace

Webasto Thermo Top C 5.2kW compact diesel boiler controlled by Heatmiser 7 day timer runs 2 school rads and 1 towel rail



WATER HEATING

11 galls (approx) lagged calorifier incorporating a blender valve for controlled hot water temperature, heated by engine, central heating boiler & 230V 1kW immersion heater • Expansion Tank • Valve to enable hot water only from Webasto boiler (on warmer days)

FURNISHINGS

Floor is fitted with hard-wearing Karndean woodeffect vinyl to saloon & bedroom and Karndean tiles to galley & shower room

BEHIND THE LININGS

Ballast: The underfloor space contains concrete bricks

Insulation: The cabin is insulated by sprayed pu foam behind all linings (except under the floor)
• Sprayed pu foam is widely recognised as the most thermally efficient form of insulation available for narrowboats. It is the only type that also acts as a vapour barrier

FINISHES

Hull: Below top rubbing strake coated with Comastic vinyl tar • Hull sides above top rubbing strake in maroon enamel

Superstructure: Two pack epoxy spray painted: Painted maroon with cream inner panels, grey/blue aft name panels & cream coachlines • Roof is painted cream • Handrails are red • Decks, roof and gunwales are finished with slip-resistant paint

Traditional decoration: Cabin sides carry traditional signwriting & scrolls • Bow carries diamonds with sun & moon either side of the stem post, counter carries cream over red panels



MAINTENANCE HISTORY

Engine: The engine is new and is yet to be run in.

Hull: The boat was last blacked in 2015 and is fitted with 4 magnesium alloy sacrificial anodes.

The warranty will not cover fair wear & tear, or faults caused by misuse, neglect or tampering. Repairs or parts to be provided by a third party and reclaimed under warranty must be approved by the vendor before being supplied.
