

At 57ft. Pond Life is an ideal length to cruise the entire connected canal and river system, giving you the chance to explore the width and breadth of England and Wales. Pond Life was certainly built to last, with good use being made of hardwearing, easy care surfaces and materials, which have been well maintained. The REVERSE layout cabin with her two sleeping compartments either side of the bathroom, make her equally suitable for two couples or as a family boat. A little touch of luxury is added by what must prove very welcoming after a long days boating, the ability to have a soak in her bath. Adjacent to the bath is a pump out toilet and the usual washbasin. Heating is provided by near silent gas fired central heating but if required it may be possible to add a solid fuel stove. A well proven, gutsy BMC 1.8 engine provides motive power. There is space in the well deck to accommodate a small table so that you can enjoy relaxing with a glass of wine whatever the weather. This boat comes with a full inventory enabling you to untie the ropes and set off on your adventures.




