The durability by Colecraft Engineering is clearly evident when you step aboard Mugwump. Here you will find well thought out accommodation, absolutely perfect for full time residential or cruising use. Mugwump has the benefit of seven berths, making her ideal for inviting family or friends aboard. Fully equipped, the galley features the usual gas cooking along with a microwave. A Victron Multiplus inverter/charger along with a 3.5kW engine driven generator provides on board energy for the fitted appliances with power to spare for any other items you may wish to bring aboard. Central heating is by Eberspacher diesel boiler, with the addition of a Bubble diesel stove in the saloon, fed by a separate diesel tank at the bow. To accommodate extra guests onboard, there is a separate toilet compartment at the aft, housing a pump-out wc and washbasin, in addition to the shower room with a second pump-out wc and washbasin. Quiet cruising is assured by the smooth running Beta engine which has a 'hospital-type' silencer. Propulsion is aided by a Vetus bowthruster.

Electrolux Travel Power engine-driven **generator** 3.5kW at variable rpm

Twin alternators: 12V 45A alternator charges 1 x 110Ah maintenance free engine battery & 2 x 110Ah maintenance free bow thruster batteries along with 230V charger • 12V 90A alternator charges 4 x 110Ah maintenance free cabin batteries • Link 1000 digital monitor displays battery and charging details • Charging also by Victron Multiplus 50A inverter/ charger

### ENGINE & BOW THRUSTER


**Beta Marine 1903 diesel** • 43hp at 2,800rpm • Built by Kubota and marinised by Beta Marine • Single lever control

Hospital silencer exhaust • Skin tank engine cooling

Fuel tank: 80 gallon (approx) integral stern tank • Lockable fuel

**Bow thruster:** Vetus 80kgf 12V bow thruster



### STERN GEAR & TRANSMISSION

Engine flexibly mounted • Centaflex coupling • PRM 150 gearbox with 3:1 reduction • Quick release weedhatch • Remote greaser stern gear lubrication • Electric bilge pump

#### **STEELWORK & STYLE**

10/6/4 plating; Shell in semi-trad style • Enhanced by: recessed cabin side panels

Fittings that are part of the shell include: Positive grip handrails and forward and aft cants • Fender eyes & midship rope eye

#### **DECKS**

Well, semi-trad and aft decks self draining • Well deck steel, semi-trad deck steel with Hexagrip board and aft deck steel with hinged steel hatch

**Brasswork:** Navigation lights, mushroom vents, chimney bands, folding steps, horn, tunnel light, fairleads, pole & plank rack

#### **WINDOWS & DOORS**

Single glazed Bronze anodised framed windows & portholes

Skylights: Three Houdini with external covers

Forward doors are hardwood, glazed, stable-style with a solid bulkhead • Side doors are steel, traditionally pannelled & painted • Aft doors are plywood, traditionally pannelled & painted • Semi-trad aft doors are steel, traditionally pannelled & painted • One side door



#### **FIT-OUT**

Linings: Cabin sides, headlining (ceiling), hull side and bulkheads (partitions) all lined in ash plywood • Framing in ash

Tiled hardwood edge galley worktops with tiled splashbacks • Washbasin splashbacks tiled

Flooring: Carpet with vinyl to galley

Insulation: Polystyrene foam







#### **SYSTEMS**

Gas: Propane gas system with 2 x 13kg cylinders

**Water**: Under deck integral 160 gallon (approx) water tank • Resin galley sink and Nature pure water filter for separate galley tap

Water Heating: Calorifier heated by engine, boiler & immersion

Cabin Heating: Eberspacher Hydronic D5WSC compact diesel boiler controlled by switch, 5 radiators, 1 towel rail • Bubble square diesel stove • Separate 14 gallon (approx) tank for heating system located in well deck locker (for Bubble stove only)
